

How to Accessing the Mercy Court of Heaven

The Mercy Court Process

Create and present your case

DEFENDANT: Dear Heavenly Father, I come before you now in the name of Jesus according to Matthew 18:18 and that the Courts of Heaven be convened over my life today.

Matthew 18:18 (NKJV)

Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

Jesus I ask that all books be open on my behalf. I address this Court Heavenly Father through Your righteous Son, Jesus Christ. I ask Father that Jesus is my Advocate and that all Court parties be present.

Presenting Accusations

DEFENDANT: Today, I bring to you Heavenly Father (Your Honor), through my Mediator, Jesus Christ, the following list of charges made against (me/defendant) by myself, others, and workers of darkness. (Present each accusation individually if possible)

DEFENDANT: Heavenly Father, I present the following accusation "Whatever it is".

COURT: How do you plead?

DEFENDANT: I plead guilty, Heavenly Father. (Agree with the adversary, confess your sin, repent, ask for forgiveness, have Jesus

heal the wound through Self Inner Healing, Ask that the blood of Jesus to be applied to this sin)

Matthew 5:25-26 (NKJV)

Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversary deliver you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison. 26 Assuredly, I say to you, you will by no means get out of there till you have paid the last penny.

Calling of Witnesses

DEFENDANT: Heavenly Father, I would request that Jesus my Mediator be called to testify on my behalf.

Closing Statement

DEFENDANT: Heavenly Father, I request the following from the court: (Provide your suggested recourse if there has been injustice against you. Relationships, Money “finances”, Restoration, etc.)

DEFENDANT: I ask that all accusations made against me be stricken/purged from all court records. (Once a verdict has been received then ask the Father if you can exit the Mercy Court)

Thank the Heavenly Father, His Son Jesus Christ and the court for what the Lord has done and exit the Courts of Heaven.

Take a moment and rejoice in the Lord for what Christ has done for you through the Heavenly Father. If you heard a decision rendered on your behalf, give glory to the Lord with a sacrifice of praise and worship or a sacrifice of financial offering. Honor the Lord with anointing yourself and taking communion.
